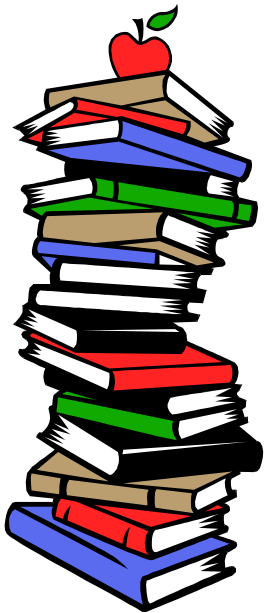


WHICH MATERIALS CAN BE CHECKED OUT OF THE CPE LIBRARY?

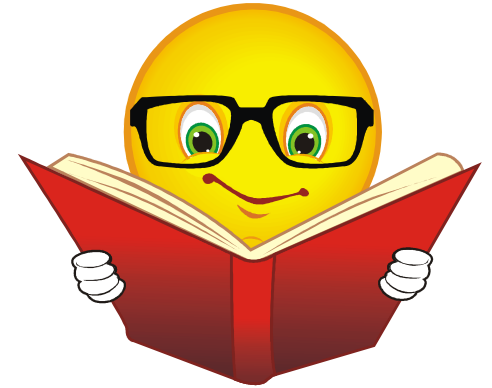

HOW MANY ITEMS MAY I CHECK OUT?

- KG and 1st grade students: 1 book at a time
- 2nd – 5th grade students: 2 books at a time

HOW LONG MAY I KEEP LIBRARY BOOKS?

- Two weeks. Please return the books promptly so others have the opportunity to read them as well.

WHAT IF A BOOK IS LATE?

- In elementary school, there is no charge for overdue books.
- If overdue, a notice will be sent home.
- No other books may be checked out until overdue books are returned.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I LOSE LIBRARY MATERIALS?

- You are responsible for the replacement cost of all materials checked out to your name.

HOW CAN I KEEP MY LIBRARY BOOKS SAFE?

- Always keep library books in the same place, so you can find them on library day.
- Keep books away from food and drinks. Do not eat snacks while reading library books.
- Keep books away from younger siblings and pets.
- In your backpack, keep books away from water bottles, markers and crayons.
- Turn pages carefully from the corners.
- Use a book mark to keep your place.

WHAT IF A BOOK I RETURN IS DAMAGED?

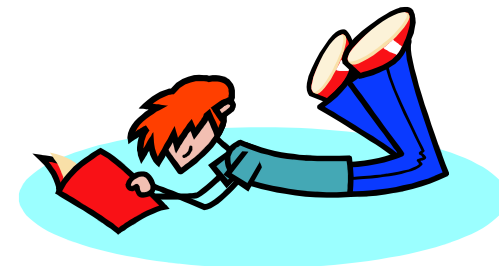
- You are responsible for any damage to books you check out. Students are reminded to check books carefully before taking them from the library, and inform the librarian of any damage.
- In case of an accident with a book, please return it to the librarian as soon as possible. Please do not try to repair a book yourself.
- If a damaged book can be repaired, a small fine may be charged.
- If the damage is significant, you may be asked to pay the replacement cost of the book.
